

## **EXCITING NEWS – TUNE INTO 91.1 FM DURING WEEKEND MASSES**

Are you still uncomfortable about attending Mass in person yet want to receive the sacrament of the Eucharist? Have you ever come to a weekend Mass only to find out the church is already at capacity?

We realize that during this difficult time, it is important that the faithful have access to the grace and comfort of the celebration of the Eucharist (Mass) In an effort to reach all parishioners (serve the homebound, bypass space limitations and allow for different technology access), we have exciting news to share.

Effective Christmas Eve, all weekend Masses will be available by listening in to **91.1 FM** on your radio. You can listen to the Mass being celebrated as you sit in your vehicle in the church parking lot (range is limited to parking lot). At the appropriate time the priest or deacon will announce that all those in the parking lot wishing to receive Holy Communion may come to a designated place outside the church or parish centre to receive the Eucharist.

Although the televised and/or the broadcasted Mass is not a substitute for participation in the actual celebration of the Church's liturgy, it does provide an opportunity for those unable to be physically present to 1) identify with a worshipping community, 2) hear the Word of God, and 3) be moved to expressions of praise and thanksgiving.
