ELECTRONIC OFFERTORY FOR SUNDAY AND SPECIAL OCCASIONS ... THE SIMPLER WAY TO GIVE.

The Electronic Offertory is a system of automatically making your offertory to the church without the use of envelopes. This is a Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) system that you authorize for a transfer of the offertory from your bank to St. Philip's Parish. This method is beneficial to both St. Philip's parish and you the donor. You do not need to write cheques or remember to bring the donation with you on Sundays. The parish reduces the cost of providing envelopes and reduces the workload on staff and volunteers. More importantly, it provides a stable cash flow for St. Philip's Church. If you are comfortable with the Electronic Offertory system as described below, St. Philip's Parish would be grateful for your participation.

Confidentiality and Security

St. Philip's Parish and the Diocese of London are committed to keeping your personal information confidential and secure. Once your banking information is entered, it becomes encrypted and only authorized staff at the Parish, Diocese and Bank have access to any of your information.

Changes and Updates are Simple

With electronic offertory, you determine how much you wish to give as regular offertory and for which special collection in addition to the regular offertory. St. Philip's Parish takes care of the rest.

If you wish to make additions, changes, or cancellation, you may do so at any time, simply by submitting a new authorization form to the office.

For other collections that may arise from time to time, you may still contribute through the regular Sunday collection... just include your name and address on the envelope.
